

Our Lady of Peace Parish is seeking a Youth Minister for 10 hours per week (with the possibility up to 20 hours). The candidate must be a fully initiated Catholic (in good standing) and if married, married in the Roman Catholic Church. The ideal candidate would have a degree in Youth Ministry or related field and have experience as a youth minister or have worked in youth ministry. The position is available immediately. The hourly rate is \$18- \$22 per hour commensurate with experience and demonstrated abilities determined by experience. Applicant must be able to pass a criminal background screening and credit check per diocesan policy.

Duties include planning and directing the Youth Ministry sessions on a weekly basis during the academic year that align with the Catechism of the Catholic Church as well as following diocesan and parish guidelines. The candidate will be required to work on Sundays during the academic school year (August-May). Develop a middle school youth group that meets on a regular basis (either monthly or quarterly) which would feed into the high school program. Communication with parents is essential; a bilingual (English & Spanish) candidate is preferred.

The youth minister completes the role by:

- Possessing strong computer, communication and writing skills.
- Be able to work with high school aged students and your team of volunteers.
- Ability to organize activities is necessary.
- Have knowledge of the practices and methods of the Roman Catholic Catechism.
- Organize, develop if needed, and execute large youth events at the parish level and work with other youth ministers at the Deanery and Diocesan level.
- Ability to maintain strict confidentiality where required.
- Collaborate with staff and volunteers for help in the Youth Ministry Program.
